Safety procedures

- Do not share food.
- Do not place cash on the table.
- Avoid touching the face.
- Wash or disinfect your hands before using this area.
- When coughing or sneezing, cover your mouth and nose with your elbow.

Hand sanitization

Begin by removing all rings, bracelets and watches

1. Apply disinfectant or soap and water and make your hands into the shape of a cup in order to cover the entire surface.
2. Rub your palms together.
3. Rub right palm on the left back with fingers interlaced and vice versa.
4. Palms with fingers interlaced.
5. Palm behind the fingers on the opposite palm with the fingers interlaced.
6. Rub the left thumb, interlaced in the palm of the right hand and vice versa.
7. Rotate the fingers of the right hand rotating back and forth on the palm of the left hand and vice versa.
8. Once dry, your hands should be clean & safe.

PROTECTION KIT FOR NON-INVASIVE CARE

Hand hygiene is the **main preventive measure** for infection control.

SURGICAL MASK

EYE PROTECTION

GOWN

GLOVES

APPLY PPE IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER

- 1 Sanitization of hands
- 2 Gown
- 3 Mask
- 4 Eye protection
- 5 Gloves

PPE REMOVAL ORDER

- 1 Gown
- 2 Gloves
- 3 Sanitization of hands
- 4 Eye protection
- 5 Mask
- 6 Sanitization of hands

PPE must be disposed of in Group III waste (biological risk) - containers with a white bag.

The non-invasive care delivery kit is intended for care provided within 1 metre. If it is necessary to carry out manoeuvres that potentially generate aerosols and more droplets protection kits should be used to provide invasive care.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

PROTECTION KIT FOR THE PROVISION OF INVASIVE CARE

Invasive care: manoeuvres potentially generating aerosols and smaller droplets (examples include: intubation, manual ventilation and aspiration, non-invasive and invasive ventilation and nebulization, cardiopulmonary resuscitation; bronchoscopy, surgery, amongst others).

CAP
Covering the ears

EYE PROTECTION
Goggles and visor

MASK
FFP2 Mask

GOWN
With back opening, single use and waterproof, with cuffs that tighten or with elastic and that covers to the middle of the leg or ankle.

GLOVES
1st inner pair and 2nd outer pair, adjusted, covering the cuff of the gown

OR

SHOE PROTECTION
Waterproof shoes for exclusive use in isolation areas, if dedicated professionals. For occasional professional entries, use waterproof, single-use shoe covers (covers boots).

INTEGRAL SUIT
Single use, waterproof, with built-in hood, neck protection and size adjusted to the professional. Replaces the cap, gown and footwear protection.

PPE's must be disposed of in Group III waste (biological risk) - containers with white bag.

MATERIALS – HIGH LOCATION SIGNAGE

- **Photoluminescent PVC (F)**
High intensity photoluminescent signage in polyvinyl chloride (PVC), 2 mm thick, with anti-static surface. This product is fire resistant and self-extinguishing.
- **Opaque vinyl (V)**
Self-adhesive PVC film, 0,08mm thick, with anti-static surface and easy to clean.
- **2 mm thick composite aluminum (T)**
Material composed of two 0.25mm thick aluminium layers and a polyethylene interior. Light, resistant and with anti-static surface.

MATERIALS – FLOOR LOCATION SIGNAGE

- **Non-slip vinyl for floor (VP)**
Material composed of a self-adhesive PVC film, 0,08mm thick, coated with a transparent non-slip protection film, in monomeric calandered PVC. The total thickness of the product after application is 0,3mm.


Slip resistance is characterized by the coefficient of static and dynamic friction:

Dynamic friction coefficient (ANSI A 137.1:2012)	
Humid	0,236
Static friction coefficient (ANSI B 101.1:2009)	
Humid	0,452

- **Opaque vinyl for floor (VB)**
Self-adhesive PVC film signage, for temporary use, 0,08mm thick and with anti-static surface.
